AWARD RULES THIS YEAR: Brockway Board members will only be allowed to win once. The Trucker's Choice and The People's Choice will be determined by votes. "The Oldest Brockway" award has been renamed "The Oldest Brockway Motor Truck" award. Farthest Distance Award will be determined by the physical address of the truck (not the truck's owner) - one for the furthest driven and one for the furthest trailered in. The 5, 10, 15- and 20-year pins will be awarded to truck owners who register their trucks **and have the trucks in attendance at the current year's Show.**
