Farthest Distance Award will be determined by the physical address of the truck (not the truck’s owner) – one for the farthest driven and one for the farthest trailered in. The 5, 10, 15 and 20 year pins will be awarded to truck owners who register their trucks **and have the trucks in attendance at the current year’s Show.**
