AWARD RULES ARE THE SAME THIS YEAR: Brockway Board members will only be allowed to win once. The Trucker’s Choice and The People’s Choice will be determined by votes. “The Oldest Brockway” award has been renamed “The Oldest Brockway Motor Truck award. Farthest Distance Award will be determined by the physical address of the truck (not the truck’s owner) – one for the farthest driven and one for the farthest trailered in. The 5, 10, 15 and 20 year pins will be awarded to truck owners who register their trucks **and have the trucks in attendance at the current year’s Show.**
